

**Hart District Council (The Yateley 10k Road Race Series)  
(Temporary Road Closure and Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2018**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Hart District Council intends making an order under Section 16(A) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 to allow the Yateley 10k Road Race Series to take place on the Wednesday 6 June 2018; Wednesday 4 July 2018; and, Wednesday 1 August 2018, and as follows:

**EFFECT OF ORDER:** on the times and dates shown in Table 1, temporary close the roads and prohibit traffic on the dates as detailed in Table 2.

Table 1 – Dates and Times for each event

Dates	Time
Wednesday 6 June 2018	19.00 hours to 21.00 hours
Wednesday 04 July 2018	19.00 hours to 21.00 hours
Wednesday 01 August 2018	19.00 hours to 21.00 hours

Table 2 – Times and Road closed for each event

Times of Road Closure for each event day	Roads and extent closed
19.15 to 20.30 hours <sup>1</sup>	School Lane (both directions) from a point measured 172 metres west from its junction with Selwyn Drive to its end with Monteagle Lane pedestrian area [road reference 72W249 FJ 01] and the start of Old Monteagle Lane
19.15 to 20.30 hours <sup>1</sup>	Old Monteagle Lane (both directions) from its start with School Lane and its connection with Monteagle Lane pedestrian area [road reference 72W249 FJ 01] to its roundabout junction with Monteagle Lane
19.30 to 20.30 hours	Cricket Hill Lane (northbound only) from its junction with Vigo Lane for a distance of 866 metres to its junction with Handford Lane

**Note <sup>1</sup>:** Once runners are clear of Old Monteagle Lane this closure will be lifted at approximately 19:40 hours, but reinstated once the lead runners return at approximately 20:00 hours and will remain in place until 21:00 hours or the last place runners are clear.

**Primary alternative routes** for Cricket Hill closure will be via Vigo Lane, and via Firgrove Road and Monteagle Lane for the closures on School Lane and Old Monteagle Lane.

**DURATION OF ORDER:** from 6 June 2018 and then on a maximum of three occasions and on the various dates and times identified in Table 1 for a period of 2 hours on each occasion or until completion of each event, and until 31 August 2018.

**Hart District Council (The Yateley 10k Road Race Series)  
(Temporary Road Closure and Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2018**

WHEREAS Hart District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the council"), as the Traffic Management agent of Hampshire County Council, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted and prohibited on lengths of the under-mentioned roads for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event as defined by Section 16A(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Special Events) Act 1994 and the Traffic Management Act 2004.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council in exercise of its powers under Section 16A(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby makes the following order:

1. This order may be cited as Hart District Council (The Yateley 10k Road Race Series) (Temporary Road Closure and Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2018 and shall come into force on 19.00 hours on Wednesday 6 June 2018 and shall apply for a period of 3 months on the dates and times indicated in Table 1 of Schedule A to this Order, subject to article 7 below.

2. In this order:

"event" means Yateley 10k Road Race Series

"the event period" means a period of 2 hours starting on the dates and at the times indicated in Table 1 of Schedule A

"a Marshall" means a person in a high visibility vest marked with SANDHURST JOGGERS

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7 below, no person shall, during the event period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in, or wait on or in any of the roads mentioned in and during the times indicated in Table 2 of Schedule A.
4. Subject to the provision of articles 6 and 7 below, no person shall, during the event period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in or on those parts of the roads or cause any vehicle to proceed in a banned direction and from or to those roads mentioned and during the times indicated in Table 2 of Schedule A.
5. The provision of article 3 and 4 above shall apply only on the dates and between the times indicated in Table 1 of Schedule A, subject to article 7 below, and during the times and on the roads specified in Table 2 of the same and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and signals, or directed by a Marshall.
6. Nothing in articles 3, 4 and 5 above shall apply to –
- (a) A motorised vehicle or motor bike or push bike being used in connection with the said event;
  - (b) A vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes; or
  - (c) Anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable in uniform or Marshall
7. This order shall be in operation on a maximum of three occasions and on the various dates and times identified in Table 1 of Schedule A for a period of 2 hours on each occasion or until completion of each relevant event or, as agreed with the council no less than 2 weeks before the dates shown in Table 1 of Schedule A, on any amended date and time up to but no later than the date given in article 8, whichever is the sooner.
8. This Order shall initially be in effect until 31/08/2018

**REQUEST FOR CONSENT TO TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES UNDER SECTION 16B OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE HART DISTRICT COUNCIL (THE YATELEY 10K ROAD RACE SERIES) (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE AND TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2018**
